### [Rich Talmon Forwarded this Article]

On our recent trip through Texas we had an engine failure. I had always heard that the engine will shut down when there is a problem to prevent further problems. Our engine shut down outside of San Antonio, Texas and would not run. We had it towed to the Cummings facility for repair. This happened over Christmas and we had to wait to begin repair.

They discovered there was a hole in the cylinder wall and let water in and also was in the oil. We had had an engine low water alarm during the trip and I added water to the radiator. I later found that this was a no-no. Cummins Inc. recommends using either a 50/50 mixture of good quality water and fully formulated antifreeze, or fully formulated coolant when filling the cooling system. The fully formulated antifreeze or coolant must meet CES14603 specifications.

Good quality water is important for cooling system performance. Excessive levels of calcium and magnesium contribute to scaling problems, and excessive levels of chlorides and sulfates cause cooling system corrosion.

Improper coolant, concentration of coolant additives, and maintenance will likely result in liner pitting and engine failure. Fully formulated products contain supplemental coolant additives (SCAs) and are required to protect the cooling system from scale and fouling, solder corrosion, and general corrosion.

This is what happened to us. We escaped a full engine replacement. Our fix was an engine cylinder wall repair plus other associated parts. They determined it was operator maintenance, my using water, so we bore the entire cost. Don't let this happen to you. Always carry the appropriate antifreeze with you and use only that to refill the radiator.


